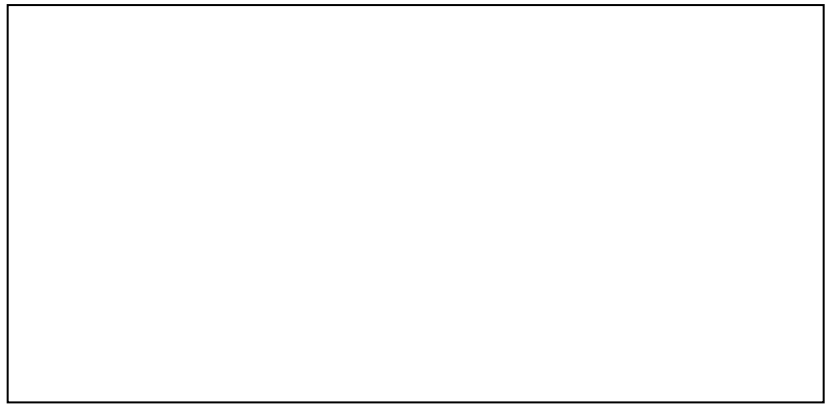
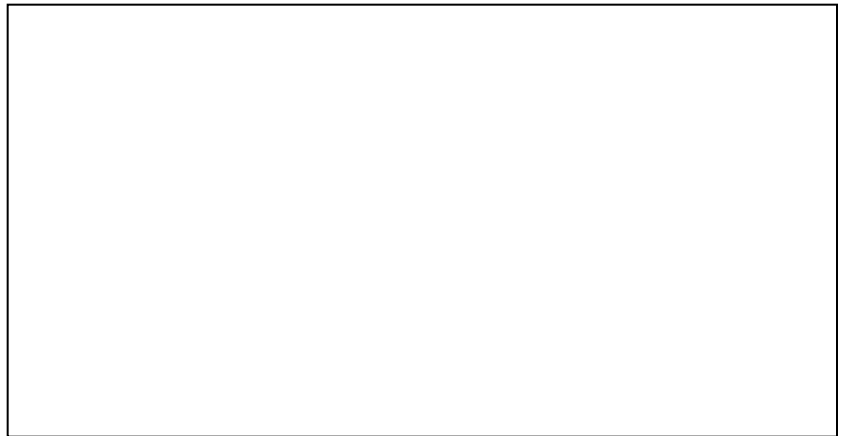


**PRESIDENTS (Draw pictures)**

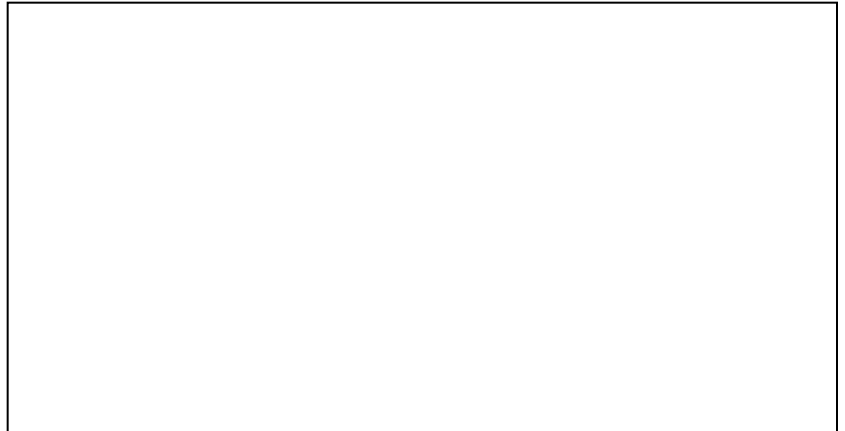
Washing Adam, Jeff got mad because he seemed to be rowing in the water. He yelled, "Adam Quit!"
